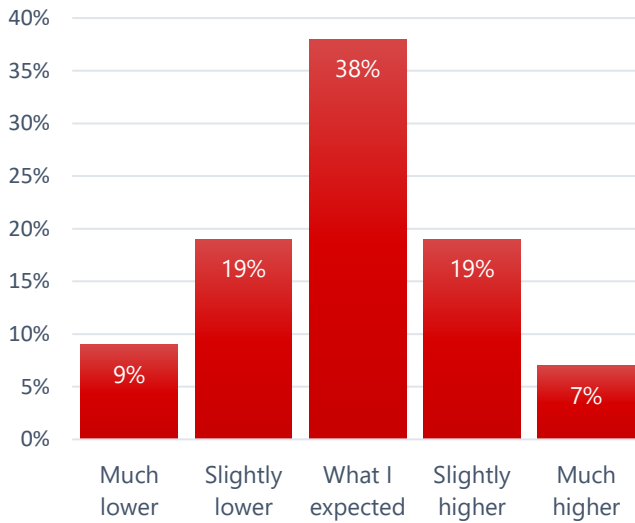

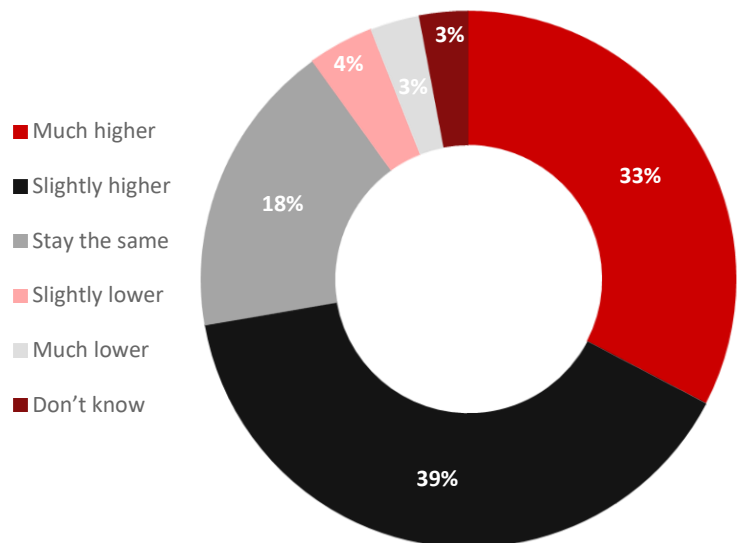


Respondents in Durack think the base rate of JobSeeker should be:
